We will make certain that the culture of these ideals pervades the public administration. The Movement will do the following:

- Demonstrate zero tolerance for unethical conduct.
- Promote and preserve the independence of the local government organs
- Encourage and respect a free press and freedom of expression
- Demonstrate the primary purpose of government is to look after the welfare of the people
- Demonstrate that "power belongs to the people"
- Create community structures to enable participation in the community decisionmaking processes.
- Be inclusive and consult with all stakeholders.
- Insists on the equitable distribution of public goods and services with consideration for the poor, elderly, and disadvantaged.





ADVANCING SPORTS & YOUTH DEVELOPMENT





- Ensure new and existing social assistance programs for single parents and other vulnerable groups are easily accessible and reaches those in need





